It had to be bespoke because the brief demanded 270° of visibility across the harbour. A problem solved by designing a faceted, outward-sloping structure with geometry so complex that every mullion and every transom is different.

And it had to be CWCT approved AA[®]110. The AA[®]110 65mm system with its deeper glazing rebate permits higher barrier loadings and enables the façade to stand up to high levels of building movement. Essential when gale force winds are the prevailing conditions.
